

Welcome to the Soldier Recovery Brigade-National Capital Region. We are located at Walter Reed National Military Medical Center, Naval Support Activity- Bethesda. Physical Address: Bldg 62, 3rd Floor, 9080 Beale Rd, Bethesda, MD 20889. Staff duty number (301) 400-0200 or (301) 547-1449.

Upon receipt of orders: Please work with your unit and servicing transportation office to coordinate your travel. Ensure that you clear your installation to include finance and CIF prior to departure. Provide a good contact number or email of the Soldier prior to arrival. Arrival: There are couple of ways to arrive at the National Capital Region: by ground, Rotator flight via BWI, Commercial Flights from Reagan International Airport (DCA), Dulles International Airport (IAD), of Baltimore/ Washington International Airport (BWI), all three Airports have USO in the vicinity. The **SRU does not provide** transportation to WRNMMC NSA-B, cabs or rental car are available for transport (based on authorized travel entitlements).

Reporting: Upon arrival at the airport, contact the staff duty number to make sure that you arrive safely in the area, Staff duty number is (301) 400-0200 or (309) 547-1449. Sign in person at the Staff duty desk upon arrival at NSA-B prior to checking in to lodging or in your assigned barracks room. If you arrive during duty hours (0800-1700) In-processing starts immediately, if you arrive after duty hours In processing starts at 0800 on the next duty day.

Cab Company with installation access: Barwood (301) 230-2242, reservations can also be made ahead of time at barwoodtaxi.com.

Lodging: For **Soldiers with dependent**, lodging is available at Navy Lodge Bethesda, <https://www.navy-lodge.com/Bethesda>. TLA authorized.

Soldiers without dependent, lodging is available at Bldg 62. Reservations are coordinated by SRU PSG/ SL.

Dining: The NSA-B have several dining options: Warrior Café, WRNMMC Galley, NEX Food court, Dunkin Donuts, Subway, and Wendy's.

Housing: There is no housing at NSA-Bethesda. The closest Military Housing is located at Ft Belvoir, Glenn Forest and Ft Meade.

What to expect: As you arrive to the Soldier Recovery Brigade, we understand that you are going through a lot of changes in your life, career, and your health. We are here to assist you and your family as you go through your treatment and recovery. You will have a team consist of a Platoon Sergeant, Squad Leader, Social Worker, Nurse Case Manager, Transition Coordinator, Adaptive Reconditioning team, Recovery Care Coordinator to facilitate your care, recovery, and assist in your transition to Return to Duty or to become a Soldier for Life.

First 24 hours: During your initial intake and in processing, you will meet with your initial team (PSG/ SL, NCM, SW) to conduct an assessment. Your team will continue on to line up your follow on care at WRNMMC moving forward. After 5 training days, you will move to Complex Care Platoon and continue with your care and in processing.
